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Day by Day

DAY 1-Amsterdam, The Netherlands– Embark

Arrive this morning. Capital of The Netherlands, Amsterdam is renowned for its museums, colorful gardens, abundance of bicycles and endless lattice of canals. (overnight)

DAY 2- Amsterdam, The Netherlands

The Dutch Golden Age's legacy lives on in gilded manses that line Amsterdam's canals and in the lush paintings that adorn the Rijksmuseum. Amsterdam Walking Tour & Canal Cruise. (overnight)

DAY 3– Ijsselmeer & Hoorn, The Netherlands

Founded in 1300, Hoorn was named for its horn-shaped harbor along the Ijsselmeer, the artificial lake created by massive dams. Hoorn Walking tour after scenic cruise of Ijsselmeer. Home-hosted Visit in Hoorn.

DAY 4- Arnhem, The Netherlands

A picturesque former Hanseatic League city nearly destroyed in World War II, Arnhem is graced with an array of beautiful parks and gardens. Paleis Het Loo Garden Excursion. (overnight)

DAY 5- Kinderdijk, The Netherlands

The South Holland village community of Kinderdijk includes a set of 19 windmills and other ingenious technologies built in the 18th century to control flooding. Kinderdijk Windmills Excursion (UNESCO site)

DAY 6- Antwerp, Belgium

Antwerp's Cathedral of Our Lady, Belgium's largest Gothic church, is a masterpiece of murals and stained glass. Antwerp Walking Tour.

DAY 7- Ghent, Belgium

Ghent, once a center of the flower seed and bulb trade, has a long and colorful history. From here, the Leie River is your gateway to Bruges. Bruges Walking Tour (UNESCO site)

DAY 8- Zeeland & Rotterdam, The Netherlands

Walcheren & Delta Works excursion in Zeeland. Rotterdam, at the heart of a maze of rivers and artificial waterways, is considered the world's largest port.

DAY 9- Amsterdam, The Netherlands

See the famous tulips of Holland. Keukenhof Gardens is the most beautiful spring *garden* in the world. More than seven million tulips, daffodils and hyacinths fill over 32 hectares with color and fragrance. (overnight)

DAY 10- Amsterdam, The Netherlands– Disembark

Transfer to the airport for your flight home.
