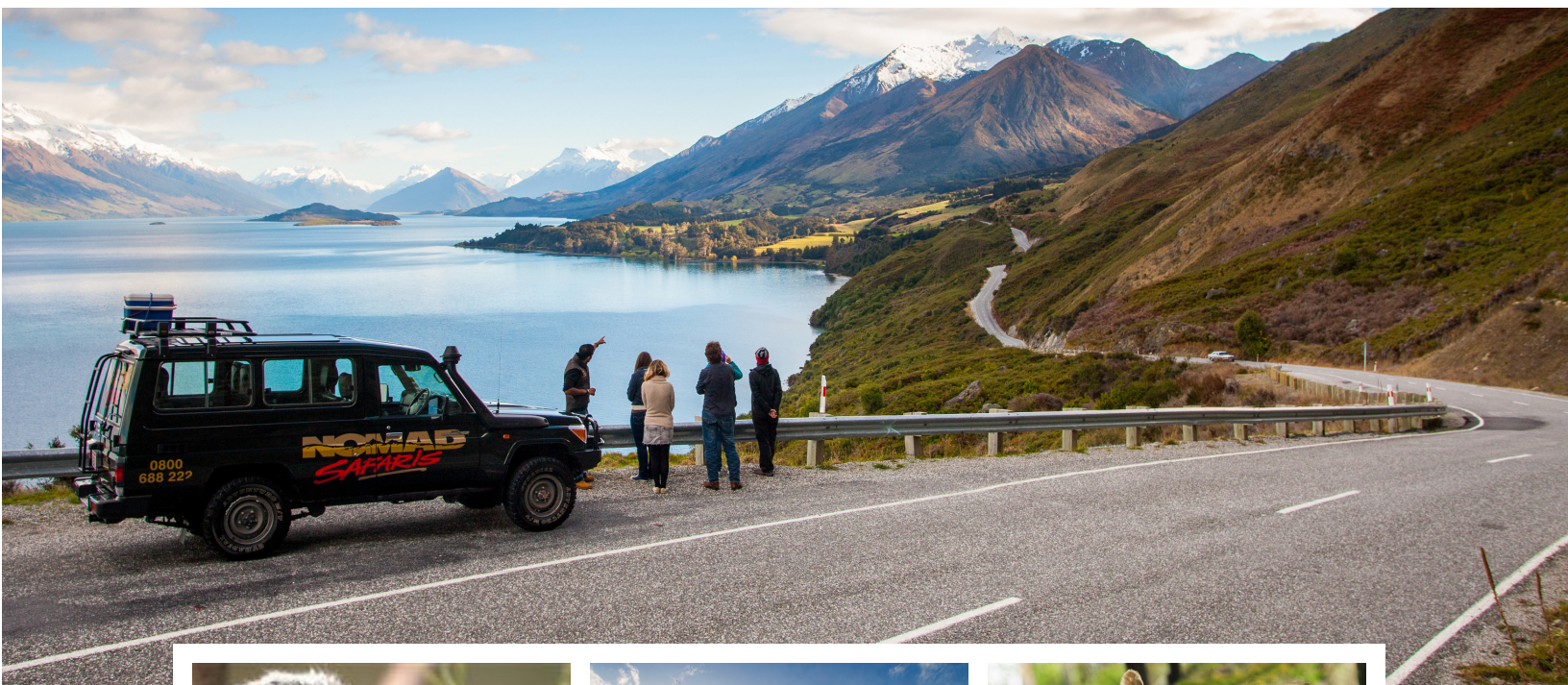

# Daily Highlights: AUSTRALIA

## DAY 1 | WELCOME TO AUSTRALIA!

Arrive in Melbourne and meet your local guide for a half day of city sights. See the Old Customs House, cruise by the Queen Victoria Market, and view Town Hall and Federation Square. Visit Eureka Tower and Australia's newest must-see attraction - Skydeck 88.

## DAY 2 | MELBOURNE

Join your local guide for a full day tour of Philip Island. Stop at the Koala Conservation Centre along the way and come face to face with koalas in their natural habitat. Make your way to the world famous Penguin Parade, Australia's most popular natural wildlife attraction.

## DAY 3 | MELBOURNE - ALICE SPRINGS

In Uluru (Ayers Rock) watch the sun light up the morning and discover the many cave paintings left behind from local Aborigines. Later, depart Ayers Rock and arrive in Cairns for an evening at your leisure.

## DAY 6 | KUKU YALANJI CULTURAL HABITAT TOURS

Travel to Cooya Beach to the Kuku Yalanji Cultural Habitat Tours. You will be greeted by a traditional smoking/cleansing ceremony, and learn traditional spear throwing among other activities. Enjoy lunch at Daintree Teahouse before your Daintree River Cruise.

## DAY 7 | GREAT BARRIER REEF

Board your Quicksilver cruise at Port Douglas and visit 3 breathtaking sites on the Great Barrier Reef, with ample time to relax, snorkel and explore spectacular sites with abundant marine life.

## DAY 8 | CAIRNS - SYDNEY

Depart Cairns and arrive in Sydney for a half day of sightseeing. Visit Sydney's trendy new Oxford Street and elegant Paddington. Enjoy a guided tour of the Sydney Opera House as you take in its fascinating history and architecture.

## DAY 9-10 | SYDNEY

Days at Leisure or Optional Excursions - Blue Mountains Day Tour (\$240pp): Journey into the heart of a unique World Heritage Region, meet koalas and kangaroos, see stunning views of Jamison Valley, view Govett's Leap Waterfall, and visit Mt Tomah Botanic Gardens.

Next, continue to Leogate Estate for a wine tasting, cheese selection, and onsite tour. Enjoy lunch and a glass of wine, then continue to Hunter Village for a chance to visit the Chocolate Shop and enjoy a final wine tasting at the local Cellar Door.

## DAY 11 | DEPART SYDNEY

Enjoy breakfast before your private coach transfer to Sydney International Airport for your flight to Queenstown, NZ.

# Daily Highlights: NEW ZEALAND

## DAY 1 | ARRIVE QUEENSTOWN

Arrive in Queenstown. Join your local guide for a private coach transfer to your hotel.

## DAY 2 | QUEENSTOWN

Take a scenic Gondola ride for quick and easy access to Queenstown's most spectacular views. Later, enjoy a Nomad Safari excursion as your 4WD vehicle takes you on a heritage tour into the historic Skippers Canyon. View Wakatipu Basin, travel to Lighthouse Rock, and journey on the historic winding road to Skippers Bridge. Immerse yourself in adventurous discovery as you visit Skippers Schoolhouse, the cemetery of gold prospectors, and try your hand at gold panning at Deep Creek.

## DAY 3 | QUEENSTOWN

Day at Leisure or Optional Excursion - Milford Sound Nature Tour (\$170pp): Journey into the heart of Milford Sound and experience the world famous fjord in all its natural glory. Visit Lake Te Anau, travel to Fjordland National Park, through Eglington Valley, past the stunning Mirror Lakes and Knobs Flat where glaciers have carved their mark on the terrain. At Milford Sound, board your cruise and explore the fjord region out to the Tasman Sea where you can see waterfalls, steep glaciers, and wildlife including seals, penguins and dolphins in the icy waters.

## DAY 4 | QUEENSTOWN - WELLINGTON

Enjoy a private coach transfer from your hotel to Queenstown Airport for your flight to Wellington. Arrive in Wellington and enjoy a private transfer to your Wellington hotel.

## DAY 5 | WELLINGTON

In the morning take part in a classic Wellington City Tour, followed by a highlights Tour of Te Papa, the Museum of New Zealand. In the afternoon take a Seal Coast Safari in your 4WD vehicle to Leaning Lighthouse, and enjoy afternoon tea.

## DAY 6 | WELLINGTON - AUCKLAND
