#### **OCT 1: DEPARTURE**

Depart USA on your flight to Japan.

#### **OCT 2: TOKYO, JAPAN**

There aren't many places on Earth that blend ancient tradition and the ultra modern quite like Tokyo. Your cruise disembarks approximately 5:00PM.

#### **OCT 3: MT FUJI. JAPAN**

Arrive 8:00AM. On clear days, particularly in winter, Mount Fuji is visible from as far as Tokyo, 60 miles away. When Japan's highest mountain is capped with snow, it's a picture-postcard perfect volcanic cone. One of the best-known symbols of Japan, this iconic mountain has been considered sacred since ancient times and was even forbidden to women until the early 1900s. Depart 4:00PM.

#### **OCT 4: OSAKA, JAPAN**

Arrive 12:0PM. For centuries, Osaka was Japan's cultural and commercial gateway to Asia - the point of entry both for trade goods and, most importantly, cultural influences that shaped Japanese society. From tea to Zen, from art to science and philosophy, Osaka was Japan's contact with the great East Asian cultures that flourished in China and Korea. Modern Osaka is home to monuments from Japan's past including Toyotomi's immense castle and the Sumiyoshi Shrine. The city is also your gateway to Kyoto, Japan's ancient imperial capital and the nation's cultural and spiritual center. Depart 8:00PM.

#### **OCT 5: DAY AT SEA**

#### **OCT 6: FUKUOKA, JAPAN**

The Shirakami Mountains, which embrace the world's largest virgin forest of beech trees, have been awarded a World Heritage Site designation. Reminders of ancient times abound throughout Aomori Port as well, and you can also indulge in the serene atmosphere of the Sannai-Maruyama Ruins, Japan's largest, which are said to have been established around 4,000 to 5,000 BC. Stroll Aomori's premiere Shinsen Ichiba seafood market where restaurateurs hand-pick fresh produce then slurp up delicious ramen noodles at one of its counter restaurants. Depart 7:00PM.
