DAY 1 - MONDAY, JUNE 15 | FAIRBANKS

From the airport, your transfer brings you to your hotel to meet your Adventure Specialist. The Golden Heart City, with its lively summer ambience and evening sun, is then yours to explore.

DAY 2 - TUESDAY, JUNE 16 | FAIRBANKS

After a brief city tour, discover gold-rush history, local heritage and only-in-Alaska culture while panning for gold at the landmark Gold Dredge 8 mining operation and cruising the Chena River on an old-fashioned sternwheeler. Enjoy the rest of the evening at your leisure. Consult your Adventure Specialist for personalized recommendations.

DAY 3 - WEDNESDAY, JUNE 17 | FAIRBANKS - DENALI

The deluxe motor coach transports you to the train station where you'll board the glass-domed cars of the Wilderness Express for the scenic rail journey to Denali. By late-afternoon, Denali is yours to explore. Your Adventure Specialist can recommend optional activities, from guided hikes to adventures like flightseeing or rafting down the Nenana River.

DAY 4 - THURSDAY, JUNE 18 | DENALI

Start the day venturing deep into the park, scouting the forest and tundra for native wildlife, on the Tundra Wilderness Tour. After your tour, your time in Denali is your own. Stroll the walking trails or chat with a ranger at the museum-like visitor center.

DAY 5 - FRIDAY, JUNE 19 | DENALI - ANCHORAGE - SEWARD

Travel in the deluxe motor coach from the wilds to the big city, where you'll have time to stroll around downtown Anchorage and enjoy lunch on your own. Admire the sparkling waters of the glacier-carved Turnagain Arm and the forest-covered mountains of the Chugach on the road to Seward, where you'll board the ship.

DAY 5-12 - CRUISE | 7-NIGHT SAILING FROM SEWARD TO VANCOUVER

DAY 5 - FRIDAY, JUNE 19 | SEWARD

Welcome aboard the Radiance of the Seas! Seward is perched on a peninsula where the ice age has had lasting power. Where ocean and mountains meet, the frosty waters and rugged coast of Resurrection Bay sustain birds, sea mammals and other marine life. Depart 8:00PM.

DAY 6 - SATURDAY, JUNE 20 I CRUISING HUBBARD GLACIER

Arrive 3:00PM. Hubbard Glacier is 76 miles long, 7 miles wide and 350 feet above the water line where it meets the bay. Watch as massive chunks of ice crash into the bay, a process known as calving that the Tlingit people call "White Thunder." Depart 5:00PM.

DAY 7 - SUNDAY, JUNE 21 | JUNEAU

Arrive 9:00AM. Surrounded by fjords, forest and snow-capped mountains, Juneau is one gorgeous state capital. Its historic downtown harkens back to its gold-rush origins and you can still pan for gold. But nature is the priceless treasure. Depart 9:00PM.

DAY 8 - MONDAY, JUNE 22 | SKAGWAY

Arrive 7:00AM. The great Klondike Rush lives on in Skagway's charming downtown of restored 19th-century buildings and its historic railway. From the vintage train, admire the mountains and see the 1898 trail that fortune seekers traveled on foot. Depart 8:30PM.

DAY 9 - TUESDAY, JUNE 23 | ICY STRAIT POINT

Arrive 6:30AM. The Huna Tlingit welcome visitors to Chichagof Island, where you can experience their rich culture and unspoiled wilderness. Inside the 1912 cannery complex visit the free museum, go whale watching in Point Adolphus or sea lion spotting in Glacier Bay National Park. Depart 3:00PM.

DAY 10 - WEDNESDAY, JUNE 24 | KETCHIKAN

Arrive 9:00AM. Ketchikan is the gateway to Misty Fjords National Monument, whose landscapes and dramatic seascapes can only be reached by plane or boat. The Salmon Capital is a hub for sports fishing and home to a collection of totem poles. Depart 6:00PM.

DAY 11 - THURSDAY, JUNE 25 | CRUISING INSIDE PASSAGE

The Inside Passage embodies the best of Alaska's pristine nature and rugged beauty. The wildlife, rainforest shrouded is mist, magnificent fjords and the majesty of the Hubbard Glacier are among many photo ops.

DAY 12 - FRIDAY, JUNE 26 | VANCOUVER

Arrive 7:00AM. Set between the sea and snow-capped mountains, Vancouver is a stylish multicultural metropolis. Disembark your cruise in Vancouver and prepare for your journey home.
