DAY 1 - FRIDAY, JUNE 19 | SEWARD

Welcome aboard the Radiance of the Seas! Seward is perched on a peninsula where the ice age has had lasting power. Where ocean and mountains meet, the frosty waters and rugged coast of Resurrection Bay sustain birds, sea mammals and other marine life. Depart 8:00PM.

DAY 2 - SATURDAY, JUNE 20 | CRUISING HUBBARD GLACIER

Arrive 3:00PM. Hubbard Glacier is 76 miles long, 7 miles wide and 350 feet above the water line where it meets the bay. Watch as massive chunks of ice crash into the bay, a process known as calving that the Tlingit people call "White Thunder." Depart 5:00PM.

DAY 3 - SUNDAY, JUNE 21 | JUNEAU

Arrive 9:00AM. Surrounded by fjords, forest and snow-capped mountains, Juneau is one gorgeous state capital. Its historic downtown harkens back to its gold-rush origins and you can still pan for gold. But nature is the priceless treasure. Depart 9:00PM.

DAY 4 - MONDAY, JUNE 22 | SKAGWAY

Arrive 7:00AM. The great Klondike Rush lives on in Skagway's charming downtown of restored 19th-century buildings and its historic railway. From the vintage train, admire the mountains and see the 1898 trail that fortune seekers traveled on foot. Depart 8:30PM.

DAY 5 - TUESDAY, JUNE 23 | ICY STRAIT POINT

Arrive 6:30AM. The Huna Tlingit welcome visitors to Chichagof Island, where you can experience their rich culture and unspoiled wilderness. Inside the 1912 cannery complex visit the free museum, go whale watching in Point Adolphus or sea lion spotting in Glacier Bay National Park. Depart 3:00PM.

DAY 6 - WEDNESDAY, JUNE 24 | KETCHIKAN

Arrive 9:00AM. Ketchikan is the gateway to Misty Fjords National Monument, whose landscapes and dramatic seascapes can only be reached by plane or boat. The Salmon Capital is a hub for sports fishing and home to a collection of totem poles. Depart 6:00PM.

DAY 7 - THURSDAY, JUNE 25 | CRUISING INSIDE PASSAGE

The Inside Passage embodies the best of Alaska's pristine nature and rugged beauty. The wildlife, rainforest shrouded in mist, magnificent fjords and the majesty of the Hubbard Glacier are among many photo ops.

DAY 8 - FRIDAY, JUNE 26 | VANCOUVER

Arrive 7:00AM. Set between the sea and snow-capped mountains, Vancouver is a stylish multicultural metropolis.
