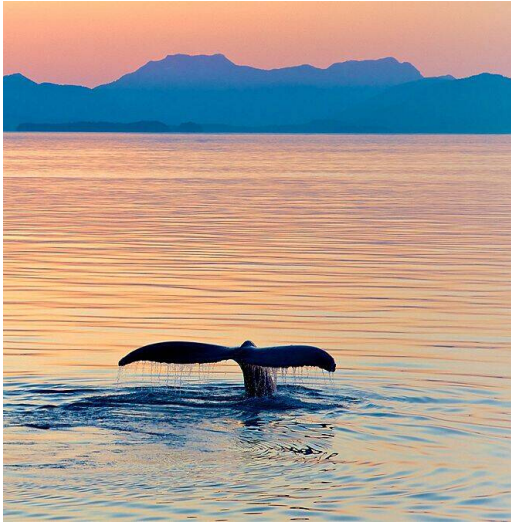


ALASKA GOLD RUSH ADVENTURE CRUISE TOUR

TRAVEL 
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DAY 1 - JUNE 29 | FAIRBANKS

Upon arrival in Fairbanks, a transfer will be provided to the Fairbanks hotel where your Tour Director will greet you. Enjoy a relaxing overnight stay in Fairbanks, a city known for its midnight sun and outdoorsy locals.

DAY 2 - JUNE 30 | FAIRBANKS

After breakfast, discover some of Fairbanks most acclaimed and historic landmarks on the *Fairbanks City Tour*, after which you'll travel to the *Gold Dredge 8* to explore Alaska's gold-mining history. This afternoon Fairbanks is yours to enjoy. Admire the enduring native art treasures on show at the Museum of the North, whose shimmering contours reflect the mountain ranges that encircle it, or explore the town born of the turn of the century gold-rush boom.

DAY 3 - JULY 1 | FAIRBANKS - DENALI

In the morning board the *Wilderness Express* glass-domed railcar for the journey to one of Alaska's most spectacular and iconic destinations, Denali. Spend the afternoon immersed in Alaska's magnificent wilderness on the *Tundra Wilderness Tour*. Discover the beauty of taiga forests and scout miles of rolling tundra while searching for native wildlife. After your tour, Denali is yours to discover. Explore the trails that surround your Alaskan lodge, set on the banks of the Nenana River or book an optional land excursion like a wilderness float trip.

DAY 4 - JULY 2 | DENALI - ANCHORAGE - SEWARD

In the morning, depart Denali for a scenic drive to Anchorage, Alaska's largest city. Stroll the downtown streets or enjoy lunch on your own, before continuing to historic Seward. In Seward, join the *Millennium* for your 7-night cruise to Vancouver.

DAY 4-11 - CRUISE | 7-NIGHT SAILING FROM SEWARD TO VANCOUVER

DAY 4 - JULY 2 | SEWARD

Welcome aboard Celebrity's *Millennium*! Seward is perched on a peninsula where the ice age has had lasting power. Where ocean and mountains meet, the frosty waters and rugged coast of Resurrection Bay sustain birds, sea mammals and other marine life. Depart 8:00PM.

DAY 5 - JULY 3 | CRUISING HUBBARD GLACIER

Arrive 2:00PM. Hubbard Glacier is 76 miles long, 7 miles wide and 350 feet above the water line where it meets the bay. Watch as massive chunks of ice crash into the bay, a process known as calving that the Tlingit people call "White Thunder." Depart 6:00PM.

DAY 6 - JULY 4 | JUNEAU

Arrive 9:00AM. Surrounded by fjords, forest and snow-capped mountains, Juneau is one gorgeous state capital. Here's your chance to take a glacial dogsled adventure in Alaska's capital, where cultured sophistication meets the ruggedness of the Last Frontier. Depart 9:00PM.

DAY 7 - JULY 5 | SKAGWAY

Arrive 7:00AM. The great Klondike Gold Rush lives on in Skagway's charming downtown of restored 19th-century buildings and its historic railway. From the vintage train, admire the mountains and see the 1898 trail that fortune seekers traveled on foot. Depart 8:30PM.

DAY 8 - JULY 6 | ICY STRAIT POINT

Arrive 6:30AM. For thousands of years, the Tlingit Indians have called this place home. Located near the city of Hoonah, and home to a historic cannery, Icy Strait Point also offers travelers the chance to view wildlife like humpback whales, orcas, seals, eagles, and brown bears, or to explore monuments to the region's fishing heritage. Depart 3:00PM.

DAY 9 - JULY 7 | KETCHIKAN

Arrive 9:00AM. You've never tasted salmon so fresh. Known as the 'Salmon Capital of the World', Ketchikan is also the ancestral home of the Tlingit people, who have carved the world's largest collection of totem poles. If you're up for an adventure, take a canoe and nature trail excursion through the rain forest or a wilderness exploration followed by a sumptuous crab feast you'll long remember. Depart 6:00PM.

DAY 10 - JULY 8 | CRUISING INSIDE PASSAGE

sail beyond the Inside Passage into the more protected Alaska Inside Passage in southeastern Alaska. This complex labyrinth of fjords, bays, and lush green islands is home to an abundance of wildlife, including orca, mountain goats, bald eagles, bears, puffins, sea otters and much more.

DAY 11 - JULY 9 | VANCOUVER

Arrive 7:00AM. Among the world's most livable cities and set between the sea and snow-capped mountains, Vancouver is diverse in cultural, beauty and culinary treats. Disembark your cruise in Vancouver and prepare for your journey home.
