Sensations of Lyon and Provence & Paris • 10 Days

Nice to Lyon • July 17-26, 2021 • Emerald Liberte

DAY 1 • ARRIVE NICE - ARLES EMBARKATION

You will be met at the airport in Nice and transferred to the Emerald Liberte Luxury ship in Arles where you will be welcomed by your Captain and crew. Tonight, enjoy a welcome reception and dinner on board. (D)

DAY 2 • ARLES

Sail into the capital of Provence, Arles. Here you will join your local guide for a walking tour showcasing the highlights of the city, in particular the 2000-year-old Roman Amphitheater still in use today. The rest of the day is yours to enjoy at leisure, either relaxing on board or exploring Arles further. (B, L, D)

DAY 3 • AVIGNON

Avignon has a rich history, from Celtic beginnings to being the residence of the Pope and central to the French Revolution. Although a fortified town, it is the Papal Palace which stands more secure on a hill in the center of town, its walls 17-18 feet thick. Your guide will take you through this historic center with its cobbled lane-ways and shops, overlooking the famous 'Pont d'Avignon'. The rest of the day is yours at leisure. (B, L, D)

DAY 4 • VIVIERS

Arrive in Viviers, a town with much Middle-Age flair and home of one of France's oldest cathedrals. Join an included tour exploring its architectural heritage. (B, L, D)

DAY 5 • TOURNON

Join your local guide for a walking tour of Tournon, which is dominated by the 16th century castle and Roman ruins, and is nestled in the valley near the steep slopes of le Massif Central, France's third-largest mountain range. The area has a long tradition in wine making, including the renowned wine growing center of Tain l'Hermitage across the river. (B, L, D)

DAY 6 • LYON

France's third-largest city, Lyon is a former Roman capital, steeped in history and considered the gastronomic heartbeat of the country. Today, embark on a guided city tour, which starts with a drive to the Basilique Notre Dame de Fourviere, Lyon's hilltop church, with stunning views over the town. Then pass by the recently rediscovered Roman amphitheater and walk through the cobbled streets of the old town, including the secret lane-ways. Alternatively, join a guided bike tour of Lyon. (B, L, D)

DAY 7 • CHALON-SUR-SAONE - BEAUNE

Chalon-sur-Saone is best known as the birthplace of photography and as the center of Burgundy's wine region. Travel by road to the quaint village of Beaune and visit the Hospices de Beaune, one of the finest examples of French 15th-century architecture. It's now a museum and has become a symbol of Burgundy. (B, L, D)

DAY 8 • DEPART LYON

After breakfast disembark your river cruise ship in Lyon and transfer to Paris by train and check-in to hotel. (B, D)

DAY 9 • PARIS

Enjoy a guided tour in Paris, passing by iconic landmarks such as the noteworthy Notre Dame Cathedral and the Arc de Triomphe. Continue exploring the city as you board a Seine River cruise, concluding at the iconic Eiffel Tower. (B)

DAY 10 • DEPART PARIS

After breakfast, it's time to bid farewell to your fellow guests and prepare to be transferred to the airport for your onward or homebound flight, taking memories of Burgundian wines and UNESCO World Heritage-listed monuments with you. (B)
