DAY 6 - JULY 22 | SEWARD

Welcome aboard the *Radiance of the Seas*! Seward is perched on a peninsula where the ice age has had lasting power. Where ocean and mountains meet, the frosty waters and rugged coast of Resurrection Bay sustain birds, sea mammals and other marine life. Depart 8:00PM.

DAY 7 - JULY 23 | CRUISING HUBBARD GLACIER (Sightseeing)

Hubbard Glacier is 76 miles long, 7 miles wide and 350 feet above the water line where it meets the bay. Watch as massive chunks of ice crash into the bay, a process known as calving that the Tlingit people call "White Thunder."

DAY 8 - JULY 24 | JUNEAU

Arrive 9:00AM. Surrounded by fjords, forest and snow-capped mountains, Juneau is one gorgeous state capital. Here's your chance to take a glacial dogsled adventure in Alaska's capital, where cultured sophistication meets the ruggedness of the Last Frontier. Depart 9:00PM.

DAY 9 - JULY 25 | SKAGWAY - HAINES

Arrive at 7:00AM to enjoy Skagway's charming downtown of restored 19th-century buildings and its historic railway from the Klondike Gold Rush. From the vintage train, admire the mountains and see the 1898 trail that fortune seekers traveled on foot. Depart 5:00PM. Then arrive Haines at 7:00PM to explore endless outdoor activities--hike deep into misty coastal rainforests and ancient spruce woodlands. Depart 11:30PM.

DAY 10 - JULY 26 | ICY STRAIT POINT

Arrive 6:30AM. For thousands of years, the Tlingit Indians have called this place home. Located near the city of Hoonah, and home to a historic cannery, Icy Strait Point also offers travelers the chance to view wildlife like humpback whales, orcas, seals, eagles, and brown bears, or to explore monuments to the region's fishing heritage. Depart 3:00PM.

DAY 11 - JULY 27 | KETCHIKAN

Arrive 9:00AM. You've never tasted salmon so fresh. Known as the 'Salmon Capital of the World', Ketchikan is also the ancestral home of the Tlingit people, who have carved the world's largest collection of totem poles. If you're up for an adventure, take a canoe and nature trail excursion through the rain forest or a wilderness exploration followed by a sumptuous crab feast you'll long remember. Depart 6:00PM.

DAY 12 - JULY 28 | CRUISING INSIDE PASSAGE (Sightseeing)

Sail beyond the Inside Passage into the more protected Alaska Inside Passage in southeastern Alaska. This complex labyrinth of fjords, bays, and lush green islands is home to an abundance of wildlife, including orca, mountain goats, bald eagles, bears, puffins, sea otters and much more.

DAY 13 - JULY 29 | VANCOUVER

Arrive 7:00AM. Among the world's most livable cities and set between the sea and snow-capped mountains, Vancouver is diverse in cultural, beauty and culinary treats. Disembark your cruise in Vancouver and prepare for your journey home.
